

Memberships Checklist for Competing at USDF Recognized Competitions

All membership and horse registration requirements must be met at the time scores are earned.

To ride in a USDF/USEF recognized show (open to all breeds) in Non-Qualifying Open, Adult Amateur, or Jr/YR class. (Additional requirements apply to Great American/USDF Regional Championship Qualifying or Championship Classes.)

- USEF Membership or USEF per show Non-Member Fee (NM)
- USEF Senior Amateur Member or Non-Member Amateur Card (Required when entering amateur classes only)
- USEF Horse ID Number (USDF HID can be used)
- USDF Membership at any level or USDF Non-Member Identification Number and USDF per show NM Fee
- USDF HID (one-time number)
- USDF Owner Membership or USDF Owner Non-Member Identification Number and USDF per show NM Fee

To earn Scores toward a USDF Rider Award (Lifetime).

- USEF Membership or USEF per show Non-Member Fee (NM)
- USEF Horse ID Number (USDF HID can be used)
- USDF Membership at any level or USDF Intercollegiate/Interscholastic Membership (IM)
- USDF HID (one-time number)
- USDF Horse Owner Membership at any level or USDF Horse Owner Non-Member Identification Number and per show fee

To compete for USDF Year-End Awards (including All-Breeds, Adult Amateur, Junior/Young Rider, Vintage, Horse of the Year).

- USEF Membership or USEF per show Non-Member Fee (NM)
- USEF Amateur Member or Non-Member Amateur Card (Required when entering amateur classes only)
- USEF Horse ID Number (USDF HID can be used)
- USDF Participating Membership
- USDF Horse Lifetime Registration
- USDF Owner Participating or Business Membership (Group membership through ADA is NOT sufficient)

All above requirements are minimum requirements.
